Opening:

Sheriff Tucker opens the meeting. Mentions 23 checkpoints were made during the 2nd quarter, without any complaints to his knowledge. Sheriff Tucker then asked the board if any of us had received a complaint. To which not a single member said yes. Sheriff Tucker also pointed out an incident report. The department responded to a call from a concerned citizen about two juveniles on bicycles displaying handguns in a threatening manner. They were taken into custody without any incident. MCSD called both suspects parents in and the parents were in agreement with the department that both juveniles should not have been in possession of the weapon and the suspects were released to their parents.

Sheriff Tucker mentioned the additional training exercises that have been attended by deputies.

Minutes from the previous meeting were brought up and each member of the board approved them and agreed they were accurate.

Joshua Tom - has questions about the checkpoints, to which Sheriff Tucker responded that those in question would be provided at the next meeting as they were dates not needed at this meeting.


-asked if anyone on the board had received a complaint from a citizen in their district. No member of the board had
